The Suffolk-made, super-nifty Air Opus camper is a great option if you're serious about going on tour whenever the fancy strikes. No man/woman cave this, the camper unfolds like a piece of giant origami and is then inflated with air in 90 seconds flat. Revealed are not only six windows to stare from, but four skylights for stargazing and dawn worship, each with a three-layer, tie-back flap – mesh to let the air in, clear plastic, and a solid cover for extra cosiness.

Prices start at £15,995 for a standard model, up to £17,995 for the Full Monty package that includes an awning. The clever folk at Opus are bringing out an off-road model soon, too, for rougher pitches.
